Some key concepts

A financial contribution

Broad concept, based on WTO and EU State aid rules

A distortion of the internal market

- Negative effect on competition in the internal market
- Subsidies that most likely distort the internal market

The balancing test

Mirroring the compatibility check under EU State aid control



Recalling the scope

Enforcement by the Commission

Mainly through redressive measures and commitments

WTO compatibility

- Comply with non-discrimination principle
- No overlap between FSR and ASCM

Besides enforcement

- Market investigation
- Third-country dialogue

Commission investigations

Procedural details on interviews, confidentiality, etc

Rights of defence

Access to file and submission of observations

Public consultation



Main challenges in FSR implementation

Maintaining trade and investment flows
